Rationing Cheat Is Fined \$2,000

Montreal, Jan. 29 (CP). — Moses Steinberg, trading under the name of Stetson Clothing Co., was fined \$2,000 today when he pleaded guilty through counsel to purchasing clothing above the maximum price, selling above the ceiling price and failing to keep proper record of transactions.

Judge Armand Cloutier accepted the amount of fine suggested by Gustave Adam, KC, special prices board prosecutor.

An additional fine of \$500 was imposed on the Stetson Clothing Co.
