

C. P. R. Hiring Number of Girls

London, Ont., Aug. 12.—(CP)—A shortage of man power has caused Canadian Pacific Railway officials here to seek women for maintenance work on tracks in the district, it was learned to-day.

The work, which has been performed by women in Windsor, Ont., for some time, consists mainly of weeding on the tracks and cleaning up the yards.

C.P.R. officials said the women in Windsor are "doing a good job and they like the work."

Women have been employed by the railway here for some time in roundhouse and car shops.
