Germans occupy all France north of line from Geneva through Tours and Atlantic Coast south of Tours.

Mined Areas to Be Swept.

All Military Equipment Must Be Surrendered.

All Aircraft to Be Grounded.

All Roads, Trains, Railways Given Up.

All Radio Stations to Stop Operation.

French Fleet to Be Ordered Home.

Merchant Shipping to Stay in Harbors.

All Military Forces to Be Demobilized.

Italy to occupy all Mediterranean Coast—Buffer States later, Nice, Savoy and part of Dauphine.



This map shows what Hitler's terms, accepted by the Government of Marshal Petain in Bordeaux, and expected Italian demands will do to France's boundaries,

leaving only a small section unoccupied by the German invaders or the Italians and without any seacoast. German terms are listed at left.
