## CANADA INTENDS TO TRY GERMANS

## Say Airmen Killed By Enemy Civilians

London, Jan. 24.—(CP Cable)— The R.C.A.F. announced to-day it will try by court-martial Germans accused of crimes against R.C.A.F. flyers forced down or who bailed out over enemy territory during the war.

The announcement did not specify what crimes will be charged but it is known some airmen were murdered by enemy civilians or servicemen after landing. Full details of the savage at-tacks will be revealed in the testi-

mony. The statement said wit-nesses will include survivors who saw mishandling of their comrades, including one airman who was shot and left for dead. Wing-Cmdr. Oliver William Dur-

Wing-Cmdr. Oliver William Dur-din, of London, Ont., probably will be named chief prosecutor for the R.C.A.F. when the trials begin. The court will be conducted along the lines of the Canadian army military court which tried and convicted S.S. Major-Gen. Kurt Meyer, but with the differ-ence that most of the accused will be charged with actually perbe charged with actually per-petrating the crimes and not ordering them.
